Assessment

We can provide assessment services to meet your needs throughout the life of your project. Environmental assessment are critical in the early stages of the development process, but there is often a role for assessments during and after a project as well. They provide us with the information and tools to make decisions about particular environmental issues.

Our assessment capabilities include impact assessments for DAs, EPA Licence applications and other approvals, environmental constraints and opportunity analyses, waste classification reports (including VENM reports) and contaminated land assessments.

Management

In addition to guiding activities of the development, these written management plans are important tools for communicating with regulators, customers and other stakeholders.
